

The Springfield-Clark County Safety Council, co-sponsored by the Greater Springfield Chamber of Commerce and the Ohio Division of Safety and Hygiene, is one of 76 such Ohio councils.

The Division of Safety & Hygiene is funded by a small portion (1%) of your employer Workers' Comp premiums. The funding provides for a number of direct and indirect services available to the employer. The goal of the councils is to help reduce employer worker's comp premiums by enhancing worker safety and health.

Membership in the Springfield-Clark County Safety Council will enable your organization to take advantage of the savings afforded by eliminating or reducing workplace injuries and illnesses, to say nothing of the positive impact on morale and productivity....the bottom line! Membership is open to all, regardless of Chamber of Commerce membership status. There is no membership fee. All that is necessary to maintain membership in good standing is:

- 1) timely submission of the semi-annual safety report which is a key for annual BWC safety recognition and our financial support, and
- 2) for the designated safety representative, CEO or alternate to participate in ten (10) of the twelve monthly meetings.

General membership meetings, featuring current safety topics, are conducted the second Tuesday of each month, 7:30-9:00 am, at the Courtyard by Marriott, downtown Springfield. The cost is \$12 per person if pre-registered and \$15 if not pre-registered. This includes the breakfast buffet.

The Council also conducts and supports many other community, business and industry safety and environmental programs. Our annual, 'showcase' event is the nationally recognized Safety Forklift Rodeo, conducted to promote the safe and efficient operation of powered industrial trucks. The next rodeo is set for October 2008.
